Requirement for the petitioner to deposit \$ 20,000 to proceed to cartway hearing was advised; legal documentation was presented to all present parties of security requirement for this petition in thamount of \$20,000 to be paid by the party presenting the cartway. C. Friesner made a motion to accept Resolution-2022-06 of the Cartway Petitioner to provide a security deposit, C. Homyak seconded the motion. Motion passed.
